



Switzerland Starts to Eliminate PFHxS, its Salts and PFHxS Related Compounds

Background

On March 18, 2024, Switzerland published AS 2024/113 (in German) to add PFHxS, its salts and PFHxS related compounds to Part I, Table of Chemicals under the Appendix A of the Elimination.

Highlight of the update:

AS 2024/133 on March 18, 2024, Decision No. SC-10/13 of the Conference of the Parties on the inclusion of perfluorohexanesulfonic acid (PFHxS), its salts and PFHxS-related compounds

Newly added chemical(s)	Application	Requirement
Perfluorohexanesulfonic acid (PFHxS), its salts and PFHxS-related compounds <i>which includes:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Perfluorohexanesulfonic acid (PFHxS; CAS No.: 355-46-4), including its branched isomers; ii) their salts; iii) all substances with the structural unit C₆ F₁₃ SO₂ – that potentially degrade to PFHxS 	Production and use	Prohibited
