

Recalls of Hard Good Products in China from April to June 2021

From April to June 2021, according to the disclosed information of product recalls from China SAMR Defective Product Administrative Center, the recall products involved including plush toys, building blocks, costume, scooters, trolley, children's toilet stools, play yards, furniture, stationeries, exercise books and traveling case products. See the table below for details.

1	Children's vehicles	Children's scooters	No handbrakes, missing safety warning signs and fixing nut of seat rods are easy to be released.	Consumer misuse, abuse and other safety risks. If the seat rod slides suddenly, it will cause the risk of falling. In extreme cases such as complex road condition or at high speed, this poses a risk of failure to brake effectively, causing unforeseen harm to children.
		Trolley	The strength of the wheels does not meet the requirements of clause 4.14 of GB 14748-2006.	Potential safety risk of falling.
2	Toys	Plush toys	The plastic bead is not fixed firmly and easy to fall off.	Risk of suffocation if swallowed by children.
		Building blocks	Plasticizer content exceeds the standard limits.	It's harmful to children's health.
		Multifunction cushion	Lack of warning on small parts.	There is risk of suffocation if swallowed by children.
		Costume	Plasticizer content exceeds the standard limits.	It's harmful to children's health.
3	Children's furniture	Children's toilet stools	Product is easy to lean forward because of structure problem.	Potential safety risk of falling.
		Play yard	Height design problem.	Possibility that children will fall down when they climb over the fence.
		Desks and chairs	Aperture size is not right, and the hole is not covered.	There may be a safety hazard of finger entrapment or body scratch.
4	Furniture	Wooden floor panels	Fracture will happen under the condition of load-bearing. Formaldehyde content does not meet the requirements of relevant standards.	Easy to cause infants and elder person to trip and fall. Formaldehyde is harmful to health.
5	Stationeries and sporting goods	Sharpener	It does not meet the requirements of GB21027-2007, there is no safety warning on functional sharp edges and points.	Lack of necessary warning poses a risk of being cut.
		Marker	There is no air hole on marker cap.	There is risk of suffocation if swallowed by children.
		Color Pen	Air hole on pen cap does not meet requirement.	There is risk of suffocation if swallowed by children.
		Rubber	Eraser products are shaped as food and have the flavor of food.	Children may swallow it by mistaking it as food.
		Exercise Book	There is sharp point.	Sharp point poses a risk of mechanical hazard to consumer.
6	Other consumer goods	Travelling cases	Handle breaks after test.	This poses dangers of personal injury.
