

China Recall of Hardgoods and Juvenile Products from July to September 2021

From July to September 2021, according to the disclosure of product recall news from China SAMR Defective Product Administrative Center, the products involved in recalls for this period are children's scooters, stuffed toys, swimming ring, pacifiers, play yards, children's toilet stools, children's chairs, nightstands, exercise book and traveling case products. See the table below for details.

1	Children's ride on vehicles	Children's scooters	The circular hole size, handle cover and thickness of plastic package bag do not meet GB 6675-2014 requirements.	1. The hole is too large, which may entrap children's finger. 2. The end of the handlebar sleeve doesn't pass tension test, which may cause children falling down during riding. 3. The plastic bag is too thin and also not be punched correctly, which may cause children suffocation hazard.
2	Toys	Stuffed toys	Phthalate content of the suction cup doesn't meet GB 6675.1-2014 requirement.	Phthalate is harmful to children's health.
3	Children's Furniture	Playpen	Product use instruction is not clear. And there is insufficient safety distance from top to possible stepping point.	Consumer may misuse it if without a clear instruction. Children will fall down and harm themselves when they climbing over the product.
		Children's toilet stools	The fixed plastic bolts become loose after repeated use, but the product instruction manual lacks warning information.	There is risk of falling after repeated uses.
		Children's chairs	The size of circular hole doesn't meet GB28007-2011 requirement.	There is a risk of finger entrapment
4	Furniture	Nightstands	Formaldehyde emission exceeds the standard requirement.	Formaldehyde is harmful to health.
5	Stationery and sporting goods	Exercise books	Sharp point and sharp edge can be found on some exercise books.	There is risk of laceration
6	Other consumer goods	Traveling cases	Product handle breaks under the load test.	Product handle breaks and then loaded case may cause harm to consumer.
		Infant Swimming aids	There is risk that the air chamber and fabric connection of product may be separated under extreme conditions.	There is risk that infant falling into the water without being supported by product air chamber
		Pacifiers	Volatile compounds are too high.	Volatile compounds are harm to heath.
