

China Recall of Hardgoods Products from July to September 2022

From July to September 2022, according to product recall news disclosed by China SAMR Defective Product Administrative Center, the products to be recalled included strollers, toys, children's furniture, children's desks and chairs, nightstands, tea tables, stationeries, candle holders, lighters, handbags, cleaning wipes. NO.	Product Category		Recall Reason	Recall Risk
1	Children's Vehicle	Strollers	Poor crimping of the product's rivets, secondary safety lock falls off during test and causes potential safety problem at the frame.	There is risk to cause child falling off from the stroller and suffers injury.
2	Toy	Plastic toys	The thickness of the plastic bag is too thin, and the holes are not punched according to the requirements of GB 6675.2-2014. There are dangerous sharp points when the toy is dropped and broken into pieces.	Once the plastic bag is covered on the face of a child, it may cover the mouth and nose, which may lead to suffocation. Sharp points may cause injury.
		Plush toys	There is no warning to show information that product is not suitable for children under 3 years old.	There is potential choking hazard due to small parts.
		Children's bunk beds	Guard rail of upper level, bed panel and ladder dimensions do not meet the GB 24430.1-2009 standard requirements. There are projections at the connection. The formaldehyde emission does not meet the standard requirement.	1. The tolerance between the guard rail and the surface of the bed panel do not meet the requirement and there is no permanent marking line, which cannot provide safety protection. The gap between the adjacent components does not meet the standard requirement that may lead to finger entrapment. The overhead space between upper and lower level is insufficient, which may cause head injuries. 2. There are protrusions at the connection. When children wear necklaces or similar objects, they may be caught by the protrusions, which may lead to strangulation or suffocation hazards 3. Excessive formaldehyde is harmful.
3	Children's furniture	Children's desk and chair sets	1. No age grade information. 2. No installation warning. 3. The formaldehyde emission does not meet the standard requirement. 4. The size of the hole does not meet standard requirement.	1. Lack of age information and warnings may lead to misuse. 2. Excessive formaldehyde is harmful to consumer's health. 3. Dangerous hole is easy to entrap fingers.
		Nightstands	Heavy metal exceeds the standard requirement.	Excessive heavy metal contents are harmful to consumer's health.
		Children's chairs	Structure safety performance such as gap dimension, stability performance against roll over do not meet GB 28007-2011.	There are risks of pinching and scissoring, together with falling out and other injury hazards.
		Children desks	Dimensions of the gap do not meet the standard requirements.	Dangerous gaps can lead to finger entrapment.

4	Furniture	Beds	Lack of Chinese use instruction.	Lack of Chinese use instruction may cause misuse risk.
		Tea tables	The edge of wood panels are not sealed and the formaldehyde emission is too high.	Splinters and burrs from wood panels cause laceration hazards. Excessive formaldehyde emission is harmful to consumer's health.
5	Stationery and sporting goods	Notebooks	There are sharp points from staples. Also the brightness of paper does not meet requirement.	The high brightness will harm the vision of users, especially primary school student. Sharp points from improper stapling cause laceration risk.
		Pens	Air hole on cap of pen does not meet standard requirement.	There is risk of suffocation if accidentally swallowed by a child.
		Glue	Formaldehyde emission does not meet standard requirement.	Excessive formaldehyde emission is harmful to consumer's health.
6	Other consumer goods	Candle holders	The stress value of the glass does not meet the standard requirement.	Insufficient stress in glass will lead to product breakage when subject to high or low temperatures or sudden temperature changes, which may cause injuries.
		Lighters	High temperature resistance, volume displacement and burning performance do not meet the requirements of GB 25722-2010.	There are risks that the lighters burst during use, which may cause fires and consumer injury risks.
		Handbags	The body of bag falls apart or being torn after load test.	There are risks to consumers when the bags with heavy load being torn apart.
		Kitchen cleaning wipes	Corrosive to metals.	The cleaning wipes are corrosive to metals, and also may cause certain irritation to human skin.
